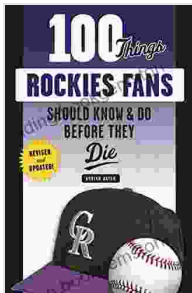


# 100 Things Rockies Fans Should Know & Do Before They Die: The Ultimate Bucket List for Colorado Baseball Enthusiasts

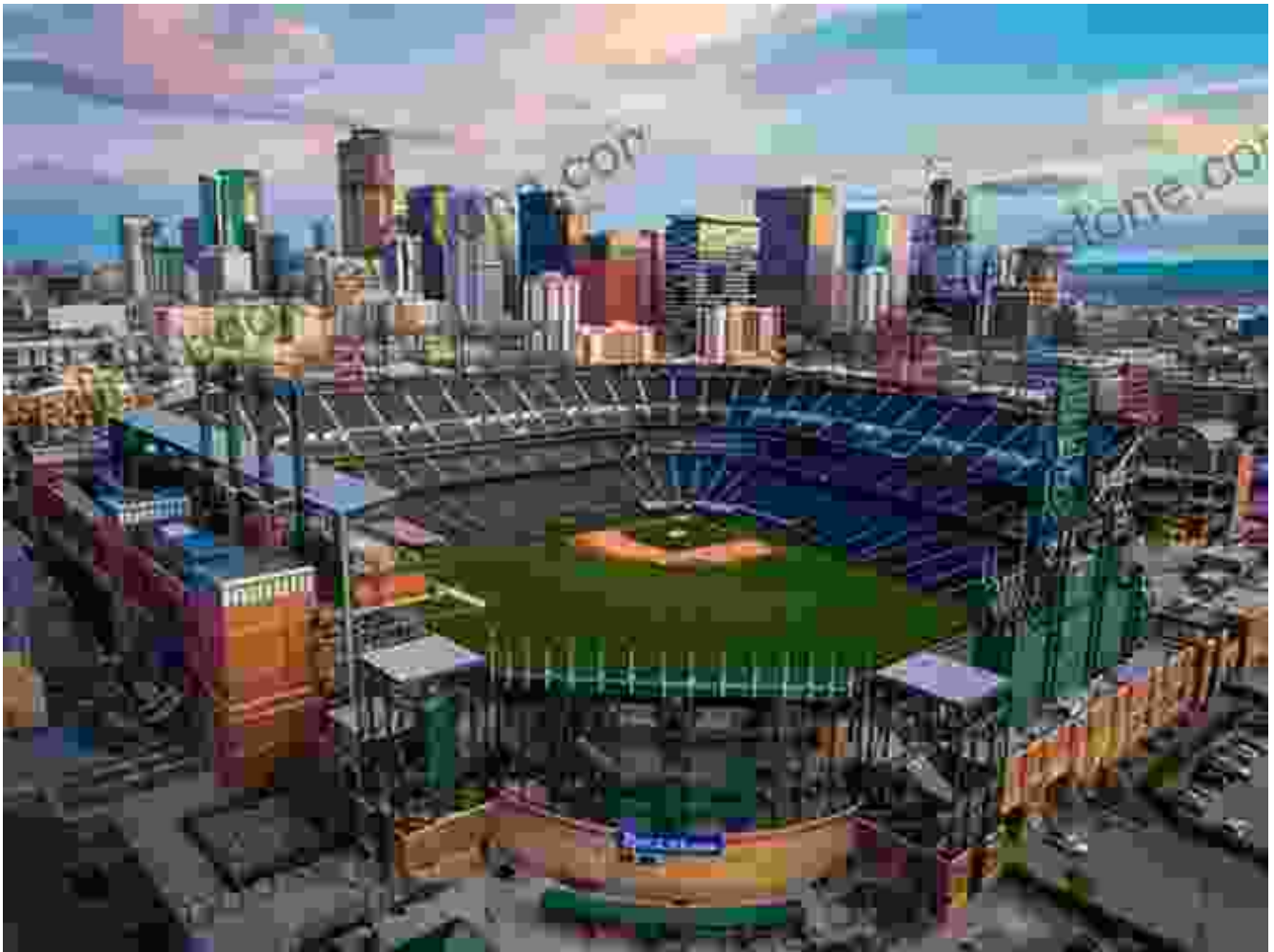

## 7. Take a batting practice tour

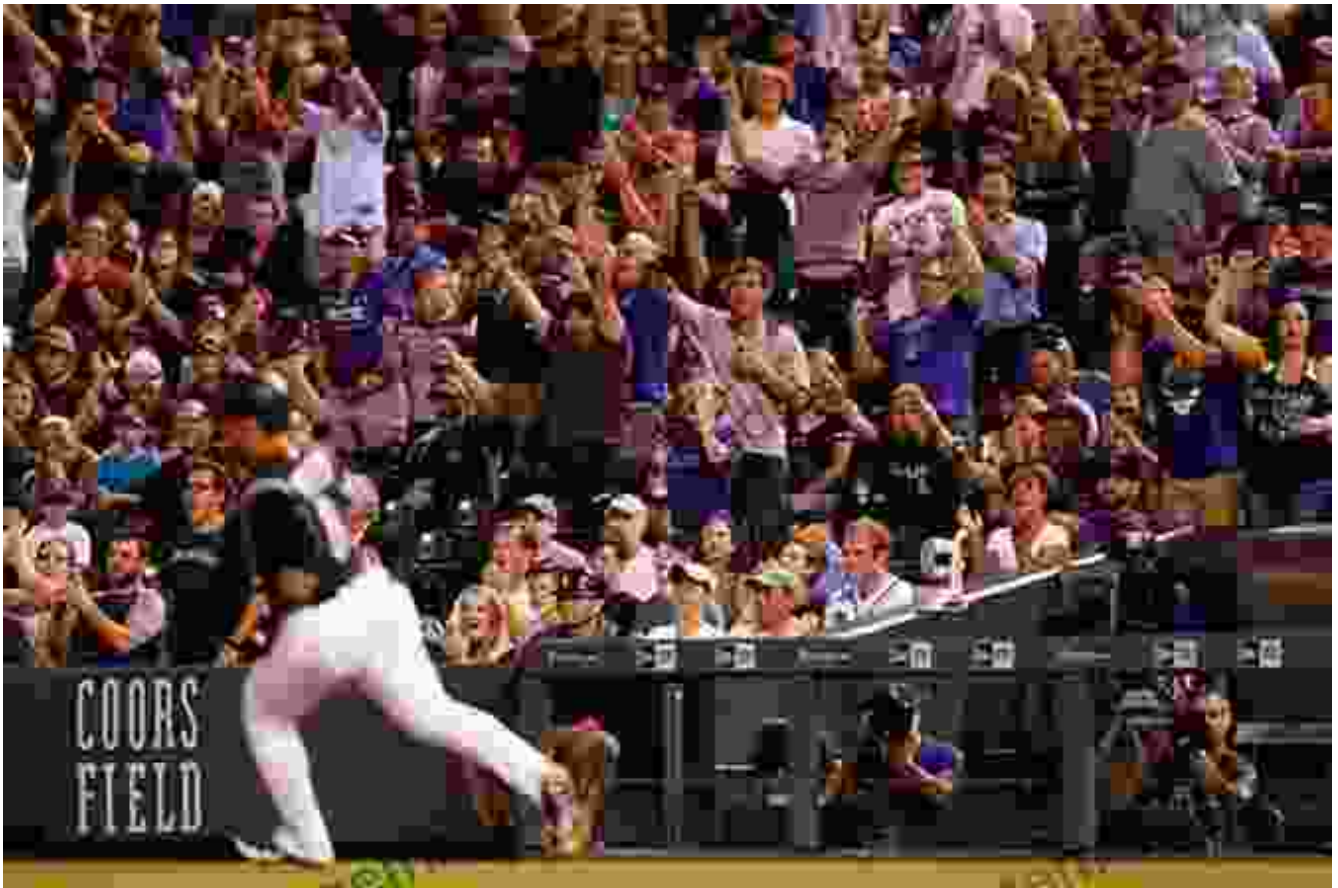
This is a great way to get up close and personal with the Rockies players. You'll get to watch them take batting practice and even take a few swings yourself.

Learn about the history of the Rockies and meet some of the team's greatest players.



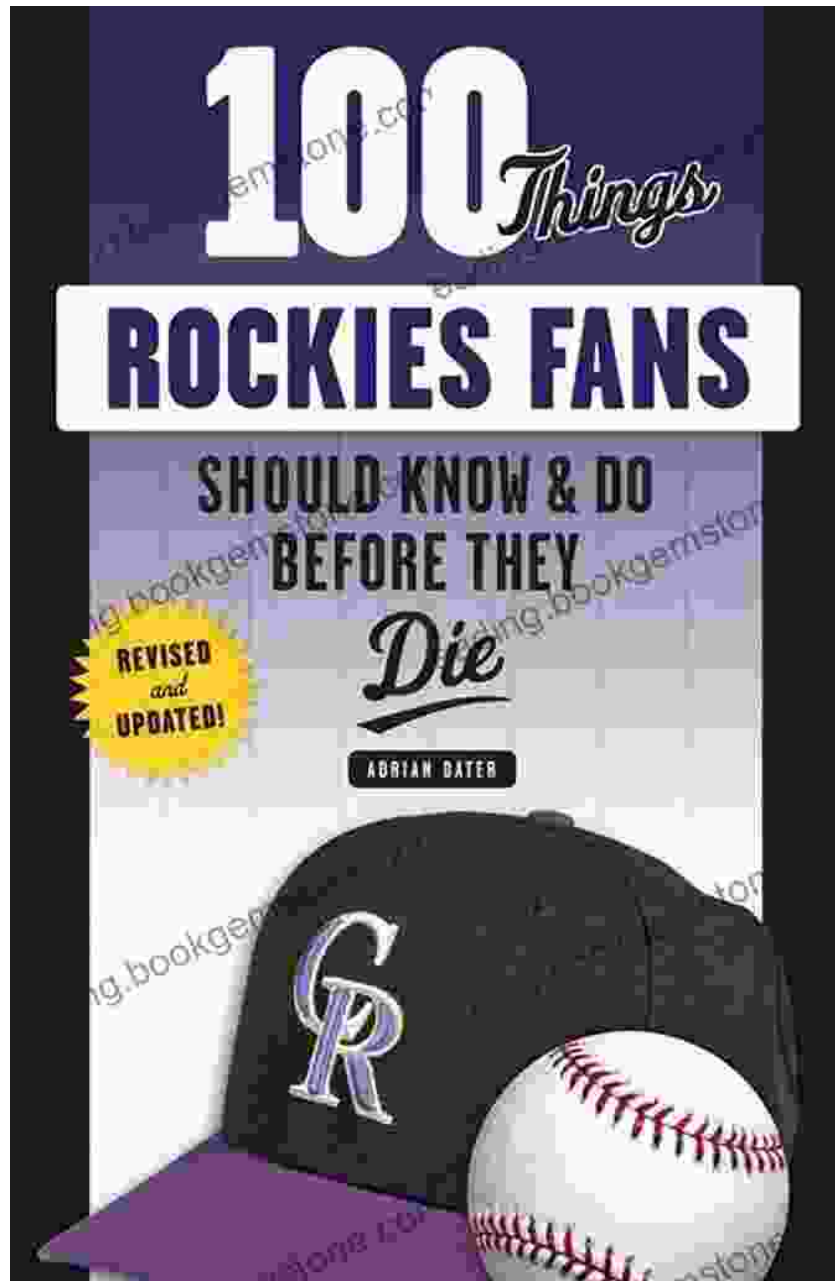
## **12. Go to a Rockies game on a fireworks night**

## **20. Go to a Rockies game on a Saturday Night Rooftop Party**

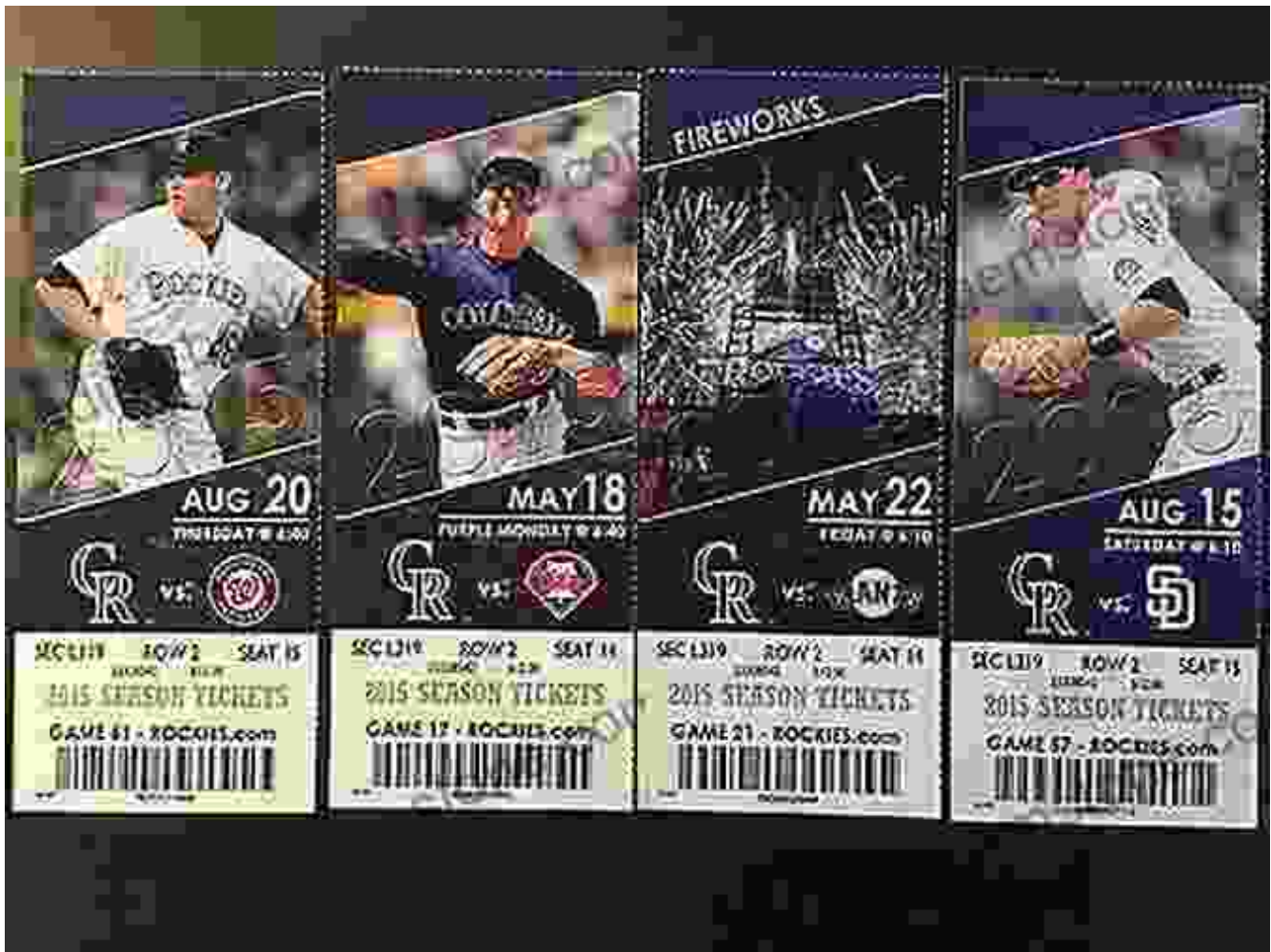
