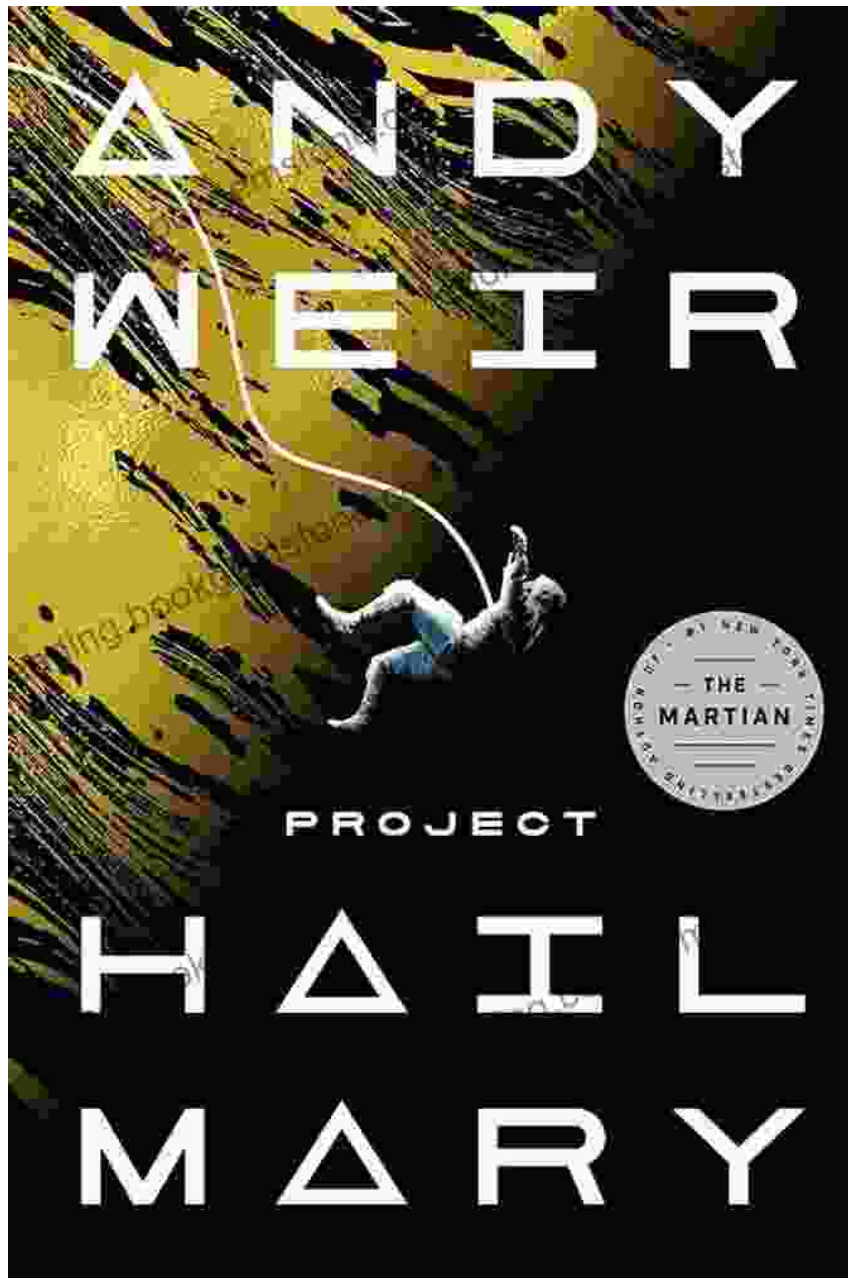

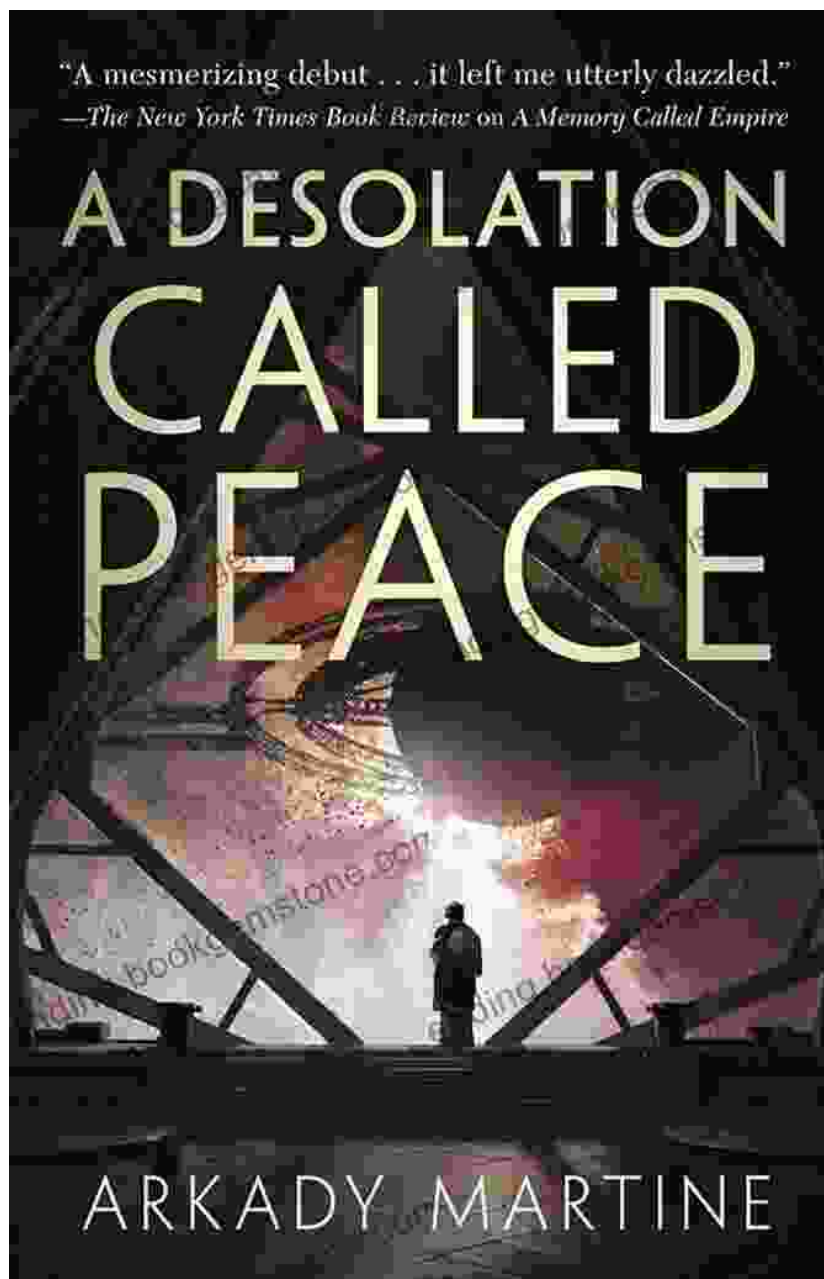
1. ***Project Hail Mary* by Andy Weir**

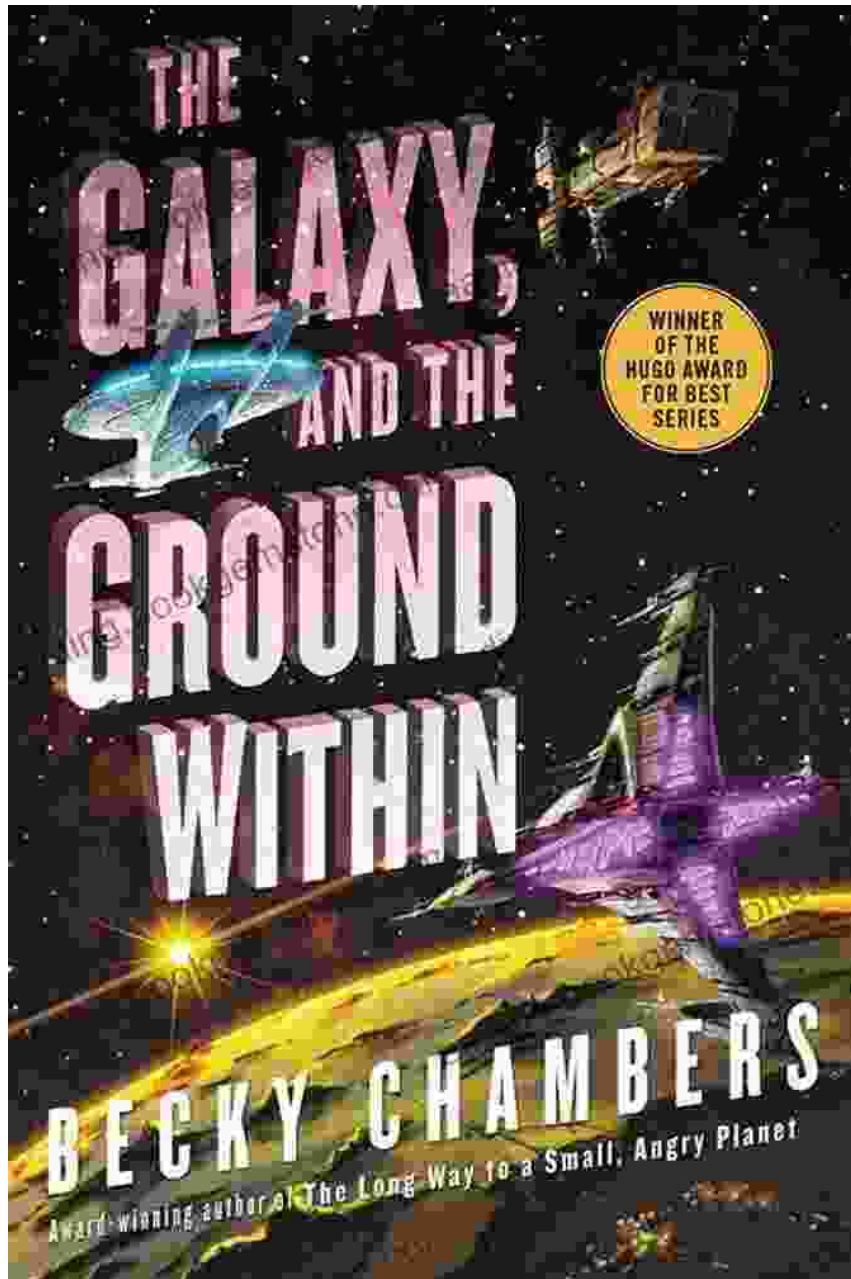

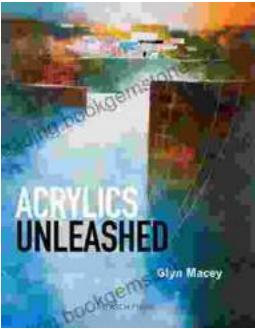

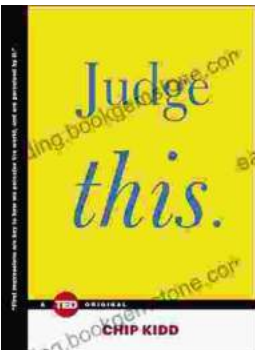
